Recently, we had to temporarily suspend all operations from 7/31-8/4 due to an outbreak of COVID-19 among our staff and guests. We reopened Friday, August 5th, and we are now fully operational. We have faced several shutdowns throughout the pandemic as case levels have fluctuated.

We are excited to announce that we recently received a \$3,000 grant from Robins Financial Credit Union (RFCU)! RFCU operates out of Warner-Robins, Georgia, and has a local branch in Athens. RFCU supports nonprofits throughout their membership areas through charitable giving. This grant will support one shelter bed and all associated costs for half of the year, providing 182 nights of safe shelter, meals, and essential supplies for a person experiencing homelessness in Athens, Georgia. Meal Providers can now choose between coming inside to serve our guests directly, or dropping the meal off to be served by staff and Evening Volunteers as we have done during the past two years. What kind of food items can be donated?

• In addition to Dinner and Breakfast meals, Bigger Vision also provides bagged lunches and snacks during the day from noon until 3 pm. We are always interested in major protein sources such as chicken, fish, etc.; however, we are also interested in expanding our side item variation on evenings when we are responsible for providing meals. Leafy greens/salads, steamed vegetables, and/or fruit bowels are wonderful options for both sides and snacks for our guests. Many of our guests also have oral health issues, so softer snack options are definitely appreciated! We can only heat up cooked food on site, so all donations must be cooked beforehand!

What are Bigger Vision's most pressing needs during the summer months?

 During the hotter portions of the year, the population that we serve is most in need of water bottles (both disposable and reusable), hygiene supplies, sunscreen, and bug spray. All of these items help mitigate the discomfort that individuals experiencing homelessness feel during the summer.

Can clothing be donated?

 Yes! We accept both new and used clean clothes without major defects. Some of the most in-demand items during the summer months include socks, shoes, boots, underwear, hats, shorts, leggings, sunglasses, and backpacks/bags.
